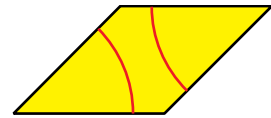
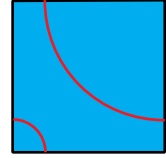


An Ammann tiling is comprised of squares and 45° rhombi.

To construct an Ammann tiling, follow these rules:

- Each time you draw a square, draw a large arc and a small one in opposite corners.
- Each time you draw a rhombus, draw a large arc at each acute angle.
- When shapes share a side, the arcs (or lack of arcs) must match.



Continue the Ammann tiling below or begin a new one, ensuring you follow the above rules.
